AlpHouse

The Alpine Space is shaped by unique settlement structures, which are key to its attractiveness. However, the traditional architecture is being threatened by negligence and urban sprawl.

AlpHouse tackled three challenges in one: energy efficiency, cultural heritage and competitiveness of SMEs. The project explored the principles of Alpine architecture and combined these with top level and energy efficient renovation techniques. Using local materials and employing local SMEs, AlpHouse has strengthened the market for energy efficient and style appropriate renovation.

Key achievements

- + Training for craftsmen, architects, planners and decision-makers (36 training modules reaching almost 600 participants)
- + Pilot construction sites in 9 regions for analyses, training and public events
- + Exchange of good practice via a travelling exhibition
