Background

Training modules are linked to the task D.T2.1.1 Elaboration of the training process to support actors to raise knowledge and increase competence. More detailed description of the overall training objectives and the course were provided in the **Circular 4.0 Transformation course (CTC) manual (deliverable T2.1.1)**.

Training materials and processes are made available to the partners on the Talents LMS learning platform and accessible to all project partners as the 2 front desk modules (Operators trainers course-OTC and Circular Acceleration Training 4.0- CAT4.0) and on line contents that support implementation of the local training actions:

Local training is composed of the Operators Training Course (**OTC**), intended to intermediaries and services providers (such as project partners, managers of regional technology parks, business incubators, accelerators, industrial clusters, public funding agencies, regional/national authorities and others supporting SMEs).

The Circularity Acceleration Training course 4.0 (**CAT4.0**) is aimed at supporting SMEs in transforming their business models from linear to circular. In the scope of the OTC the CAT4.0 is aimed to operators to better understand the issues of the SMEs dealing with the circular transformation in company setting including assessing where company stands today and where it's needs are for the circular/digital transformation.

Other capacity-building on-line components available over the Talents LMS platform that are part of the overall Circular 4.0 transformation course, including OTC and CAT4.0 are:

- study visits presentations and recordings (D.T2.2.1),
- train the trainers with EU CE team (D.T2.2.2.),
- a training evaluation methodology (D.T2.5.1) and the
- set of tools i.e. the "toolkit" to be used by operators, assisting SMEs on circular economy and digitalisation issues (Circular4.0 toolkit developed in the scope of D.T2.3.3) are also available as part of the overall Circular 4.0 Transformation Course, including the OTC over the website: .

The OTC and CAT 4.0 trainings can be conducted online in the language selected by the regional partners, and assisted with the materials in ppt or video formats in English or other partner language made available on the Circular 4.0. Transformation course e-learning platform TalentsLMS: <https://circular40.talentlms.com>.

Course in local language is encouraged to be put on Talent LMS to be further on collectively used by the Alpine Space circular economy community i.e. by operators from various regions in the Alpine Space and wider in Europe. Instructions for putting local OTC training course on line are provided below and on the Talent LMS platform.

The duration of each module is somewhat flexible, and it can be carried out in the format of a live seminar or webinar sessions. Participants are acquainted with the entire programme in advance and are asked to study preparatory materials in order to be able to actively participate in the trainings. The estimated time period for delivery of the OTC is 15 hours including the individual preparatory work of participants.

STEP 3: EVALUATION OF THE TRAINING COURSE & CERTIFICATS

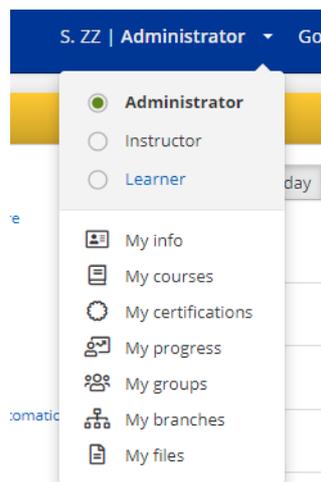

Operators/project partners can choose to use in part or fully the training course provided in English on Talents LMS e-learning tool.

1. Visit OTC website on Talent LMS (<https://operatorstrainingcourse-circular40.talentlms.com/>). OTC can also be accessed via a web page with the Circular4.0 toolset: <https://circular40.eu/>.
2. Signup on the top right corner and create an account
3. Log into your account

6. After becoming a learner you can start the OTC training by choosing “Introduction to the Operators Training Course” on the list of all courses.

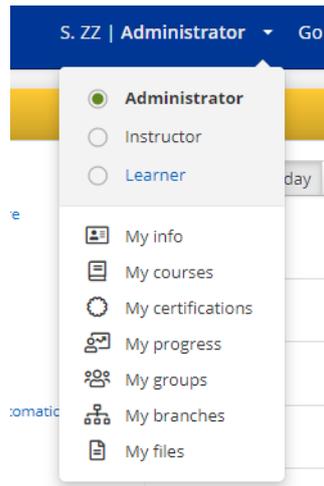
