Working session “Land-saving through regional spatial planning documents and local implementation”

Summary and key messages:

- Existing alliances focus on different thematic aspects of land take:
 - Development of rural areas, one component is inner development/ vacancy management
 - Protection of soil, quantitative and qualitative aspects of land take
- Exchange of differing interests as key to collaboration on land-saving measures
- (Net-)Working on different spatial levels is necessary; the local and regional level and their (political) acceptance are essential for implementation
- Alliances focus mainly on information activities as thematic events, workshops, pilot projects
- Discussion: consideration of qualitative aspects of land take, e.g. by means of soil function maps, “soil check” for municipalities
